

Director of Children Part-Time Job Description

Job Goals:

To develop and implement a ministry for the children of ESBC.

- a. Encourages the development of close Christian friendships based on the teachings of the Bible, trust, and acceptance among all children and youth.
- b. Builds positive attitudes towards the church and its leaders.

Job Responsibilities:

- 1. Provide leadership in developing and coordinating a comprehensive ministry for the children.
- 2. Develop a positive Christian relationship with children and their families.
- 3. Design effective programs and activities where the children can use their abilities, talents, and spiritual gifts to minister to others as service to the Lord.
- 4. Organize, plan, and participate weekly, monthly, and throughout the year in children's activities that are spiritual, educational, recreational, and appropriate for the age group.
 - i. Activities for each age group include but are not limited to Bible studies, Bible school, summer programs, and other seasonal activities.
 - ii. Make an effort to be present in extra-curricular activities as time allows.
- 5. Assist or lead a Sunday morning class as needed (not included in paid hours).
- 6. Assist with children's music rehearsals and performances.
- 7. Coordinate and communicate with the director of youth on any combined events and activities as needed.
- 8. Coordinate communication through newsletters, social media, text messaging, etc.
- 9. Provide outreach and follow-up with children visitors and their families.
- 10. Work closely with the pastor:
 - i. In church planning with special emphasis on worship and inclusion of children and youth.
 - ii. Keeping the pastor informed of any children, youth, or family concerns.
- 11. Upon being hired, a 3-month probation period will begin; the Personnel Committee will complete reviews and evaluations as necessary.

Requirements:

- Must be eligible for and/or possess a valid North Carolina driver's license.
- Will be subject to a criminal background check.

Other Qualifications:

- The director of our children should have a strong foundation in the Christian faith and be a strong follower of Jesus Christ, (educated in the area of his call, and have the experience that matches as well, is desirable).
- He/she will be a good example of commitment, follow through, reflect professional workplace etiquette, and be responsible in all aspects of the position; must possess good communication skills and reflect high moral and ethical standards.
- Must have a passion for children and youth and be able to incorporate that passion into the ESBC fellowship.
